FAMILY DEVOTION

The Fruit of the Spirit: *“Patience”*



“I Will Walk In Patience!”



“Wait patiently for the Lord. Be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the Lord.” - Psalm 27:14

Say:

People are not very patient, generally speaking. We are so used to not having to wait for anything - instant coffee, overnight delivery, on-demand video, etc. These things have really spoiled us. We have become very impatient people.

Christians are supposed to demonstrate patience. It's an important fruit of the Spirit. Sadly, we rarely have patience with others or, even worse, patience with God. Impatience with God shows a clear lack of trust in Him and His ability to provide for our every need.

Read:

Genesis 40:23-41:46

Ask/Discuss:

- How long did Joseph have to wait in prison?
- Who mentioned Joseph's name to Pharaoh?
- What did Joseph do for Pharaoh?
- What did Joseph say was coming to Egypt?
- How did Pharaoh reward Joseph?

Say:

Through the story of Joseph in prison, we can learn how to patiently wait on God to act. If we will be patient, He will always come through.

Ask/Discuss:

- What are some moments in which it is difficult to be patient?
- What can we do in the moments we are becoming impatient?

Pray:

Pray that God will help your children who may be dealing with impatience with God and others to trust Him completely so they can be patient and wait on Him.
