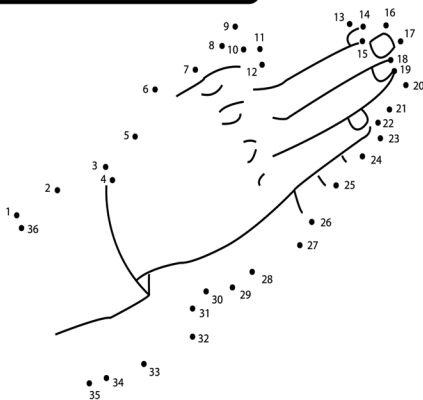

FAMILY DEVOTION

BLESSED: “Answered Prayer”



“God Will Answer When I Pray!”



“Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you.” – Matthew 7:7

SAY:

Many people are intimidated by the idea of praying to an almighty God. They think they don't have the right words to say. Sometimes, they even think they are not worthy enough to talk to God.

Too often, people buy into the lie that God doesn't really hear them when they pray. They believe that God is not interested in their everyday lives.

READ:

1 Samuel 1

DISCUSS:

SAY:

We can pray with confidence, knowing that God hears us when we pray. Not only does He hear us, but He will answer.
