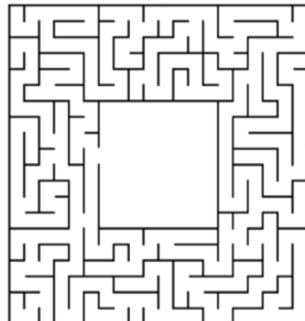

“My Enemy Is Big, But My God Is Bigger!”



“Don’t be afraid, for I am with you. Don’t be discouraged, for I am your God...” – Isaiah 41:10

READ:

Numbers 13:1-14:9

DISCUSS:

- What was the name of the land God had promised the Israelites?
- How many spies did Moses send into the land?
- How many of the spies came back with a bad report?
- What were the names of the two spies who came back with a good report?

SAY:

When Moses sent the spies into the land of Canaan to check out the land, he expected them to come back with great news. Instead, ten of the twelve spies came back with reports of how impossible it would be to take over the land. But Joshua and Caleb reported that, although there were giants in the land, God was greater and able to give them the land. They understood that God is bigger than any problem they would face.

The same goes for you and me! God is bigger than any difficulty or problem we may face in life. We just need to trust God and keep our focus on Him!

DISCUSS:

- What are some problems or difficulties you are facing?
- In what ways can you put your focus on God in the middle of those problems or challenges?

PRAY:

Pray with your children that they would not focus on their problems, but on the God who can deliver them from those problems. Pray for God’s deliverance in their lives.
